Each board, commission or agency of this state or of any political subdivision thereof shall include in the notice of any meeting or hearing, if notice of meeting or hearing is required, of such board, commission, or agency, conspicuously on such notice, the advice that if a person decides to appeal any decision made by the board, agency, or commission with respect to any matter considered at such meeting or hearing, he will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purpose he may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.

As a follow-up to my email dated October 26, 2020, I would like to document the outcome of the Valley View Homeowner's meeting on October 25, 2020.

The Homeowners Association of Valley View Estates met to vote on the issue of paving the neighborhood roads at 6 pm on Sunday, October 25, 2020 at the home of Jerry and Jane Schoonover. With 25 owners present a quorum was established.

After a presentation on the lots and ownership in the neighborhood, and on the various paving options that provide for different road widths for consideration in reducing costs, and further discussion, an owner made a motion to base the assessment for the cost of the paving project on the 32 resident owners instead of the 48 lot owners. The motion was seconded and approved by the voters unanimously. Voters were provided four voting options.

The "Cadillac" option provides for an 18-foot road width along the length of Valley View Trail from US 90 to Valley View Ridge and 10-foot road widths on Valley View Ridge and Valley View Ct. and would cost an estimated \$732 per resident owner each year for ten years in the special assessment.

The "moderate" option is different from the Cadillac option, reducing the road width along the east/west section of Valley View Trail from the curve to Valley View Ridge to 16 feet and would cost an estimated \$710 per resident owner each year for ten years in the special assessment.

The "modest" option is different from the Cadillac option, reducing the road width along the east/west section of Valley View Trail from the curve to Valley View Ridge to 14 feet and would cost an estimated \$688 per resident owner each year for ten years in the special assessment.

The fourth option is to vote no.

The treasurer, Julie McCall presented a treasurer's report and after discussion an owner made a motion to approve the project to pave the roads in Valley View Estates. The motion was seconded and passed with just one "no" vote, including the votes submitted by proxy before the meeting. Including the proxy votes, 26 voted for the Cadillac paving option, six voted for the moderate paving option, one voted for the modest paving option and one voted no to paving. The vote exceeded the requirement for a 75% vote of support by the neighborhood covenants to expend money for this paving project.

Having established overwhelming approval from the property owners, the Valley View HOA stands ready to move forward with Jefferson County on the project to pave the roads in the neighborhood.
