The Board met this date in regular session. Present were Chair JT Surles, Commissioners Betsy Barfield, Stephen Fulford, Eugene Hall and Stephen Walker. Also present were County Attorney Scott Shirley and Clerk of Court Kirk Reams.

- 1. Chairman Surles called the meeting order. Commissioner Hall led the invocation and pledge of allegiance.
- 2. Kerry Irons gave a presentation on the United States Bicycle Route System and discussed the route to Jefferson County via US-90. It was the consensus of the Board to place this item on the agenda for the next meeting.
- 3. On motion by Commissioner Walker, seconded by Commissioner Barfield and unanimously carried, the consent agenda—consisting of the approval of the agenda as amended, General Fund/Transportation Vouchers, BOCC Minutes for 9/17/2020 and added item of Property Appraiser Budget Amendment—was approved.
- 4. Clerk of Court Kirk Reams gave an overview of the two potential FRDAP grants that Jefferson County would be applying for: the Lamont Community Park as well as renovations to our horse arena. On motion by Commissioner Walker, seconded by Commissioner Hall and unanimously carried, the Board voted to move forward with application for the Lamont Community Park. - 5. Clerk of Court Kirk Reams introduced the CARES Act update item. David Jahosky, with GSG, gave an update on phase II of the CARES Act plan. He noted that the website was up as well as the brick and mortar location and stated he was fielding applications.
- 6. County Attorney Scott Shirley introduced the Valley View self-assessment item. He stated that the Valley View project is on hold, pending the 10/25/2020 Home Owners Association where they will vote whether or not to move forward. Mr. Grubbs, from the Valley View HOA, stated he would call Attorney Shirley after the meeting to let him know whether or not it is approved.
- 7. County Coordinator Parrish Barwick discussed the Thompson Valley culvert damage and stated the Road Department would need to repair it.
- 8. County Attorney Scott Shirley stated he would be providing an update on the Capital Trucks bankruptcy at the next meeting and how it could potentially affect our county.
- 9. Chairman Surles publicly thanked the Sheriff and Solid Waste Departments for their efforts in cleaning up road sides.
- 10. On motion by Commissioner Walker, seconded by Commissioner Hall and unanimously carried, the meeting was adjourned.
