### **Iuror Selection**

The juror selection process is based on your Florida Identification. Depending on the nature of the trial, a Circuit Judge or a County Judge will conduct the juror screening process to determine who the final jurors will be. At the end of this process, the judge will typically select six final jurors and two alternates who will be expected to stay for the duration of the trial. Not everyone who receives a summons will be selected as a final juror; however, each person who receives a summons and is an eligible juror must report to the courthouse to avoid legal fines and potential imprisonment. Below is the Jefferson County Clerk of Court Jury Summons document.



### **Reporting for Service**

You must call (850) 342-0218 and then dial \*300 for reporting instructions.

All citizens should report to 1 Courthouse Circle, Monticello, FL 32344 promptly by 8:30 a.m. on the posted reporting date. Please report to the south entrance on the first floor of the courthouse for processing. Upon arrival, jurors are kindly met by security personnel and screened through a metal detector. Remember to bring your jury summons to the courthouse so the Clerk may check you in. After processing, there may be delays before the trials begin.

## Dress Code

The mandatory attire is business casual. Please dress appropriately and modestly: no shorts, open-toed sandals or flip-flops, excessively baggy pants, crop tops, hats, or tank tops will be permitted. If you appear at the courthouse dressed inappropriately you will be dismissed. Additionally, do not bring a purse, handbag, cell phone, or weapon inside the courthouse. All personal items should be left in your vehicle. **Anything brought inside the courthouse is subject to search**.

#### <u>Amenities</u>

The restrooms are conveniently located to the right upon entering. There is also a restroom located in the jury room. Parking is in the public lot adjacent to the Jefferson County Courthouse.

The time and duration of recess depend solely on the judge's discretion. Occasionally, a meal will be provided during recess if it takes place during mealtimes and the trial has lasted a considerable amount of time. However, be

prepared to purchase a meal or wait until after the trial to eat depending on timing.

# **Juror Compensation**

Jurors whose employers are compensating them for the duration of the trial will not be additionally compensated. Those not being compensated by their employer will earn \$15 per day, and \$30 per day after three days of service. The checks will be administered by mail.

# **Generous Jurors Program**

If your employer does not compensate you for jury duty, you may now donate your daily compensation to Refuge House. Refuge House provides direct services to domestic abuse and sexual assault survivors and community education in all eight counties of the Big Bend Area of North Florida. Let's make a positive impact together!

# **Requests for Excusals or Deferrals**

The valid reasons for **optional** excusal for service are as follows: expectant mothers, parents not employed full time with children under 6 years of age, people 70 years or older, and people who served as a juror in their county within one year.

The valid reasons for **mandatory** excusal for service are as follows: law enforcement officers, municipal police officers, convicted felons, people under prosecution for any crime, and people who no longer reside in Jefferson County. You may complete the Juror Excusal and Postponement form included in your jury summons packet if you qualify for the excuses listed. If you meet one or more of these criteria, you will be excused unless you are notified otherwise.

You may be eligible for deferral if you have a reason for missing a jury summons that is not provided above. Please call our office or email the Clerk to see if you qualify for a deferral.

If you require an excusal form for work or school, we will be happy to provide you with that documentation as well.



#### <u>Fines</u>

If you are an eligible summoned jury member and decide not to attend the courthouse on the day of the trial, you will be fined \$100. For trials of the Circuit Civil Court, absent citizens are subject to imprisonment for abandoning their civil duties. If you experience extenuating circumstances that affect your ability to complete jury duty, please communicate with the Clerk of the Circuit Court.

## American Disabilities Act (ADA)

If you are a person with a disability who requires accommodation to participate in the proceedings, you are entitled, at no cost to you, to the provision of certain assistance.
