- 4. Carol Ellerbe, Emergency Management Director, requested professional services related to debris removal.
- 5. On motion by Commissioner Monroe, seconded by Commissioner Sutphin, and unanimously carried, Ellerbe's request was approved.
- 6. County Coordinator Roy Schleicher presented the County Coordinator's report to the Board.
- 7. Fire Chief Mark Matthews presented Grants Applications to the Board.
- 8. On motion by Commissioner Hall, seconded by Commissioner Sutphin, and unanimously carried, the Grants Applications were approved.
- 9. Property Appraiser David Ward presented the Board with a citizen's request to refund a special assessment on vacant property.
